What a fantastic little trailer. We were due to move in a week or so from it's delivery and guess what was going to carry the lot. Hi All @ Easytrailer,

Just a quick note to let you know that the package with the extra bolts and also the paperwork for the easytrailer arrived here today. Firstly let me say that I was surprised that the whole trailer fitted into 7 small boxes! I had to continually check that I had all of the boxes, anyway just an observation, that I made that it said on the carton, "Box number XX of 3 boxes make sure that you get all 3 boxes" well I immediately thought oh no! I haven't got it all but then I realized that the third box must contain the floor, I think that you might want to warn people that when they are buying a trailer without the floor to disregard this.

I unpacked the cartons on Wednesday night and made sure that everything was there and got a few tools organized and had a cuppa while I checked everything out. I was a little bit taken back when I first started reading the instructions and saw that the trailer is made in China and I thought this is going to be a heap of cheap crap and nothing is going to fit together properly on a bit of a closer look though I couldn't believe the quality of the parts to start with, they are the real deal from the high tensile bolts and the powder coating on the rails, to the wiring loom it is all quality stuff. Anyway yesterday I got into build mode and this morning I have a 99% complete trailer sitting in my driveway, even with making my own floor out of the aluminum 5 bar tread plate that I got from Aluminum Express while I was down your way on Monday I though that this was going to be difficult but I've got to tell you it went together without a hitch. The other thing that I noticed while putting it together is just how quickly a bloke on his own can put one of these together!

Other things that I wasn't quite prepared for was the need to put tech screws into the HD side rails but a quick trip to the industrial supplies store here and I had it sorted out in a couple of minutes, you might want to let people know this when they order the panels as it took me a little off guard when I was confronted with a bag of 48 tech screws to put in, lucky I already had a power drill but if for instance you didn't have any power tools you might run into trouble.

At first I was a little unsure about putting down so much money to buy something that you had to then put together, but my initial fears where soon forgotten when I look at the quality of the trailer. Anyway I am very very happy with my new trailer and will be sure to pass on my satisfaction to all, being in the Army we move around quite a bit and you always have more stuff than you can fit into a car when you go on posting and then there is the need to put the trailer somewhere when you get to the other end it either lives on the lawn and kills the grass or goes in the garage and the car is left outside, now the problem is solved I have the best of both worlds.


The children enjoyed themselves with, show bags, glow sticks,face painting, hair colouring and hoopla, while the parents enjoyed our now famous Auction.

Attached are the pics of the single Hobie Adventure Island mod to your 880GA trailer.

The kayak sits on Rhino Commercial Racks fitted with the rear loading Rhino kayak cradles.

The racks are attached to a 2m 50x50mm RHS bolted to both sides of the trailer frame which overhangs the trailer by 90cm. The trailer lights are attached to the ends of the RHS which means the 4.8m kayak only overhangs the trailer by about 40cm.

Hey Alex.

Just wanted to report back after the build, as it were.

No damage to parts, all bits present and accounted for. Threw together the basic trailer in under a day, even with 'help' from my two daughters. I'm really impressed with the simplicity and easy, ordered logic of everything. I certainly wasn't on a mission or anything...the trailer just seemed to come together in between cups of tea and a bit of quiet tinkering. Quite satisfying.

All of the (many) accessories I ordered fit up easily, and overall I'm really taken with their heavy duty build quality. The Heavy Duty sides kit is particularly good - proper thick gauge steel and good, deep powder coating - and the 'ramp claws' are a genius touch to make loading bikes foolproof and safe.

One tiny, minor, hair-splitting niggle is the form ply floor - or rather the sharp edges on it. I slipped with my ratchet whilst snugging up a corner tie down point and opened up a very impressive gash on my thumb. Clumsy of me, sure, but a chamfered edge would be safer.

But I'm being picky. This is a really good product...so much so that yet another riding mate of mine, having seen my 6X8 'mothership', will be ordering his soon. Well done!

#### Alex

The trailer towed well from Brisbane to Birdsville where we unloaded the Suzuki Dr650.

I had packed a bit more grease into the wheel bearings of the trailer before I left, as well as using a spring washer ,2 flat washers and a loctite nut at every connection point to ensure that nothing came loose during the trip. Nothing in fact did come loose. This is surprising as a lot of the time the trailer was literally airborne!

We then towed the trailer unloaded over the sand dunes and across Eyre Ck.

It was virtually submerged crossing the creek. We flipped the trailer that night and checked the wheel bearings but they were fine.

On the way to Mount Dare 540km across the Simpson Desert from Birdsville, the trailer was under water and in deep bog holes on many occasions but nothing seemed to worry it. However we were concerned about the loose hitch and tried to keep it tight. Eventually the hitch mal-functioned twice near Mt Dare. The trailer jumped off the towball.

We eventually worked out what the problem was to cause this.

The threaded bolt that you tighten on the hitch is about 10mm too long. When going over sharp humps the end of the bolt hits and levers the hitch off the drawbar on the vehicle. In the end we cut 10mms off the bolts to sort the problem. On the the return we had a bit of excitement. The road near Mt Dare is through gibber plains and the road is strewn with big rocks and diabolically rough. We ended up not surprisingly with a flat tyre on the trailer. A wheel rim was bent. We knocked it back into shape with a hammer. Pumped up the tyre. Hey presto no problems after that . No flats again incl all the way back to Brisbane.

At Eyre Ck I drowned the bike so it was put on the trailer for the crossing. This was in actual fact the last time I rode the bike as it wouldn't start. We towed it over sand dunes including Little Red.

We realised that the weight bias with the bike loaded on was wrong and the towball had an upwards force on it. This was only apparent on the off -road stuff.

We had to reposition the bike channel further forward to get the weight forward on the towbar.

Once on the bitumen the 4WD drove over a huge roo carcass. The trailer axle hit it and bent. This meant that trailer wheels were not true. We had to jack the axle to straighten it out as best we could. I'll have to replace it.

All in all the trailer had an absolute flogging being towed 1000km across and back through the Simpson Desert. The flat tyre and bent axle were not the trailer's problems.

Improvements are the hitch bolt size and the positioning of the channel further forward to get more load on the tow ball. I can send you the part of the bolt that we cut off if you want.

The trailer did the job through unbelievably tough terrain.

I'll send photos once I have received the ones taken by others in order to send you the best ones. These photos will illustrate what i have mentioned above.

The parts that suffered the most damage were the removable sides and the mud guards. However, because the trailer was battered as it was dragged along by the floodwaters the 2 rails that hold the castor wheels have been bent out of all proportion. Also, the 2 side pieces that hold the bar that in the middle and the bar itself have been damaged beyond repair.

I have included a couple of pics so you can see the damage it sustained and I must say that I was impressed by the way the trailer held up to the battering it received on its journey. I am trying to rebuild the trailer as it was uninsured at the time due to an oversight on my part - will be insured from now on I can assure you. Hi folks, just thought I would share 'my' version of your  $8 \times 4$  which I purchased recently. The sides are made of  $190 \times 35$  treated pine, the rear drop down gate is  $240 \times 45$  treated pine hanging on ball bearing hinges which allow removal if required, and also held in place by two catches. The rail around the top is made of metal fence rail ( $38 \text{mm} \times 25 \text{mm}$ ) to allow for light tying down of loads, and inside I have secured four, low, tie down points which will allow for occasional motor bike transport. The motorcycle wheel chock has not been added yet. All timber and railing has two coats of Killrust gloss black.

Very happy overall, and super light to tow with my Ford Focus. Using timber additions also means the trailer has minimal rattles when towing. Very quiet.....Could this be the first 'Stealth' trailer ??:-))))). Only hassle is that one of the running lights has died...can't get to it yet as I have 'pinged' my back this morning! PS...I work in a hardware store so all (except rear catches which came via Ebay) items were readily available. Kind Regards,

### Photos and video of easy trailer adventures over 8 years

Please find enclosed a flash drive containing some photos and videos of places we have taken our boat on our easy trailer over the past 8 years. I purchased the easy trailer whilst living in Brisbane and coincidently it arrived on a transport the day my brother arrived from Melbourne in his truck. I put him to work and we were instantly impressed of how easy the trailer was to put together, but then skeptical of how we would go on the road towing a boat.

How wrong we were to doubt this ripper little trailer. My partner and I are avid freshwater fisho's and we'd tow our boat 7 hours north of Brisbane to Awonga dam or Callide at Biloela on 40oC qld days when the roads were melting dozens of timers each summer, charging 3000km round trips to Eucambene in the Snowy mountains several times too chase trout and when we moved to Albury in 2010 loaded up our boat on the easy trailer with a 1/4 ton of outdoor furniture and moved to Albury NSW. In 8 years we've had 2 boats, 3 motors, 2 new vehicles and we are now on to our third set of tyres for the easy trailer. It's never held us up ever, it's ever reliable and after 10's of thousands of km's on some really testing roads and tracks is still running on its first set of bearings.

In short, it's been amazing!!

Some added advantages of our easy trailer over conventional boat trailers.

- 1) Fuel economy wasn't hardly altered on long trips due to the overall lightness of the outfit
- 2) During the 10 years of drought (2000-2010) when impoundments receded below record level we were able to manually launch our boat with the help of a skid we installed behind the tow hitch.
- 3) Being so light with minimum weight at the hitch made manual handling our setup a breeze.
- 4) We fished remote areas away from cement boat ramps with a 2 wheel drive vehicle as we could launch and retrieve our boat with a rope, or portable electric winch. Four wheel drivers were often amazed by our Aussie ingenuity?
- 5) On many trips, especially Eucambene we kept fishing while other fisho's had to sit at camp on days when weather was treacherous by virtue of being able to launch in steep sheltered bays out of the weather where there was usually no boat access!

Around a year ago I purchased a 2nd hand 6x4 easy trailer that had been extremely well cared for. The original owner had purchased it in kit form and assembled it himself. He had done a great job and since i have had the trailer it has done a great job for me.

Last Easter (2015) i loaded it full to the brim with camping gear and a kayak and towed it some 1500 kms to our favourite camping spot without any issues whatsoever. My brother on the other hand had purchased a new galvanized kit trailer (assembled) and after only around 400 kms it had already started to come apart forcing us to head off in search of bolts and nyloc nuts to repair it.

Today I went to collect some vinyl flooring tiles from the supplier and there wer 44 boxes at an estimated weight of 10kg per box. The palet was loaded onto the trailer and positiond properly. I checked the load about halfway home and felt the bearings and all was fine. I arrived home without a problem. I then broke open the palet wrapping and lifted the first box and it seemed heavier than 10 kg so i weighed it and it was actually a shade under 20 kg. This made the load around 880 kg.!!

I just thought you should know that although this is way above recomendations and regulations the trailer handled it without issue.

Thakyou for making my Easy Trailer so tough. I love it!

I thought you may like to see how one of your 8' x 4' folding trailers turned out when I converted it to a fixed tipping box trailer.

The tail gate can be opened flush with the bottom of the trailer, so that it can then be used as a  $10' \times 4'$  "flat bed".

To get heavy stuff on board, the trailer can be tilted using the jockey wheel at the front, and the tail gate becomes a boarding ramp. A marine winch mounted up front then enables the object to be easily winched uphill.


Finally, a two-tarp system allows for a variety of load heights to be properly covered against the weather.


